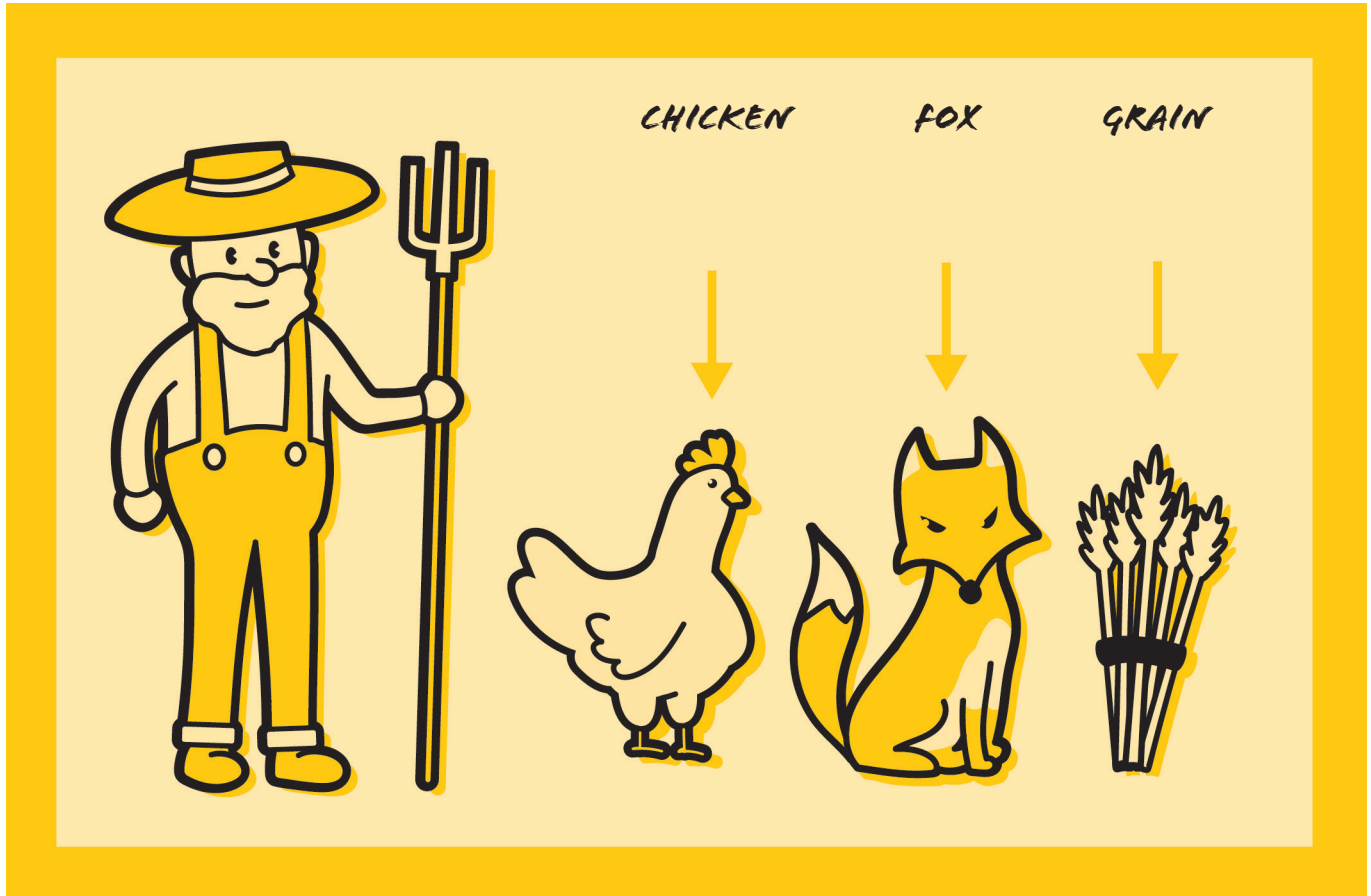


A CHICKEN, A FOX, AND SOME GRAIN
