IKE IS STANDING BETWEEN SAL AND TODD,
WHO IS SHORTER THAN ED, BUT TALLER THAN IKE.
VAN IS STANDING BETWEEN ED AND IAN,
WHO IS STANDING NEXT TO TODD.
THERE ARE SEVEN MEN STANDING BETWEEN VAN AND TED.*

5. Jimmy's mother had four children. She named the first Monday. She named the second Tuesday, and she named the third Wednesday. What is the name of the fourth child?
